

GWEN E. WILSON MEMORIAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship, known as the Gwen E. Wilson Memorial 4-H Scholarship Award, is to be awarded to an Allen County 4-H Club Member, annually. This scholarship must be used at Kansas State University for work leading to a degree of the student's own choice.

The scholarship is worth \$500. No winner may receive it more than once and it is not renewable. Part of the award is payable upon completion of enrollment at Kansas State University; and part upon completion of enrollment at the beginning of the second semester of the awardee's first year.

This scholarship award is to be presented to a new awardee each year. The awardee must be recommended by the Allen County Extension Agents as having a creditable 4-H record for at least three years, and as a person of good moral character. The awardee is also to be recommended by his or her high school principal as being a capable student and as being of good moral character. Financial need, scholarship, and 4-H club records shall be considered in the selection.

This scholarship is to be used in the school year following selection unless postponement is requested by the awardee and recommended by the County Extension Agent and approved by the State 4-H Club Leader, in which case postponement cannot exceed 2 years.
