

CLOTHING PROJECT JUDGING INFORMATION

JUDGING – TUESDAY, JULY 10, 2018

This year we are privileged to be able to use the F.S.C.C. Danny and Willa Ellis Family Fine Arts Center for judging. Please NO FOOD OR DRINKS in the lobby. There are water fountains for your use.

Judging Schedule:

See Judging Schedule sheet for times and other information.

Clothing Construction Judging:

Remember to sew a label into each garment piece constructed before conference judging. You will need to make your own labels. Type or print on 3"x2" piece of cloth: name, class number, county/district name. Sew label on inside of garment (back of neck, center back of waistband, or left end of apron band.) Fair entry cards only need attached to your garment when entering the fair on Monday, July 16th.

Buymanship and Construction Fashion Revue:

Forms are available in the Extension Office and on the internet – www.southwind.ksu.edu. Click on Fairs then Bourbon County all forms are located under Fashion Revue. The judge will consider the completeness of all forms for your placing.

If you are in Buymanship Fashion Revue, you will need to complete the 2 "B" forms for each entry:

1. Script Information Buymanship Garment Fashion Revue
2. Evaluation Guide for Buymanship Fashion Revue (front and back of sheet). All Levels must complete the Cost per Wearing section, **there are no right, wrong, or too expensive costs.** The purpose of this section is for you to think about how much you paid for your garment, how many times you'll wear it and how much it will cost to care for it.

If you are in Constructed Fashion Revue, complete the 2 "C" forms for each entry:

1. Script Information Constructed Garment Fashion Revue
2. Evaluation Guide for Constructed Fashion Revue (top of sheet).
*Recycled Garments must provide a "before" picture of the garment item.

Note:

Constructed entries must be exhibited for the duration of the fair to receive premium money. Members must participate in the Public Revue Thursday, July 19, to receive ribbon, premium and special prizes.
