## Dorothy and Clyde Copeland Scholarship Application

- The following instructions will be used in applying for the Dorothy and Clyde Copeland 4-H Scholarship
- Return your application package to the Southwind Extension District Erie Office by July
  1<sup>st</sup>
- The applicant must have completed three years or more as a 4-H member of Neosho county or project club.
- The application must include these four items:
  - 1. A written application, which contains all of the information requested below.
  - 2. Transcript of high school grades or most recent college semester grades if already in college.
  - 3. One letter of recommendation from school personnel.
  - 4. One letter of recommendation from a 4-H leader or agent.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

The application should be 2 to 4 pages in length, single-spaced and one sided. You may use any format you desire, however, the 5 criteria below must be addressed. The application should be similar to a resume. The total score for each will be weighed according to the percentages for each category.

## Full name (First, Middle, Last), Address and Telephone

- 1. Demonstration of providing leadership at the club, county and district level to build stronger 4-H club or county programs 40%
- 2. Demonstration of providing leadership in school and community 25%
- 3. Demonstration of achievement in 4-H activities and project work 10%
- 4. Awards, honors and participation in statewide events 10%
- 5. Educational plan 10%
- 6. Need 5%
