### **ENROLLMENT DETAILS – Allen/Bourbon/Neosho**

Families will pay 2023-2024 4-H Program fee.

Enrollment and payment must be complete by

December 1, 2023. Due to many payment issues, all
families will be asked to pay the \$15.00 4-H Program

Fee per member when enrolling. It will be best to do
this with a credit or debit card. This will ensure that
your enrollment and fee will be processed more
quickly. In December, Clubs will receive a list of
4-H'ers who receive reimbursement and a check.

The club treasurer will then write a check per family
to reimburse for the program fee. Cloverbuds and
Volunteers are exempt. Youth aged 18: If you plan to
participate as a 4-H member you will need to enroll as
youth. If you plan to be a volunteer in 4-H only, please
enroll as an adult.
