IMPORTANT POULTRY INFORMATION

Birds exhibited at the county fair in the Southwind District that originate from Kansas do not need to be tested before the fair until 2027. Birds will then be tested every 5 years. Now, if your bird comes from out of state you will be required to test within 90 days of the fair or show proof of clean flock certificate.

The 2024 Fair theme is "Walk the Red Carpet With 4-H". Members are encouraged to use Hollywood decorations for all Livestock Stall Entries, Poultry and Rabbit Exhibits, 4-H Club Banners and Booth Displays.

POULTRY AND RABBIT PROJECT MEMBERS

*Rabbit Fryer Pen Rules: A Fryer pen will consist of a pen of 3 rabbits either all male or all female. They must all be of the same breed and each exhibitor will be responsible for obtaining their own rabbits. Exhibitors are limited to 1 entry. Weight of pen should range from 10 lbs. to 17 lbs. The fryer pen will count as 1 of the maximums of 2 species an exhibitor is eligible to sell.

*Poultry Broiler Pen Rules: A pen will consist of 3 birds of the same breed male or female. Birds will all come from the same hatch with Superintendent placing the order for the bird's minimum of 10 birds per exhibitor to be picked up approximately 6-7 weeks prior to fair. Exhibitors must notify Extension office prior to this date if participating in this project so enough birds can be ordered. These will be Cornish Cross. Exhibitors are limited to one entry. Weight of pen should range from 12 lbs. to 19 lbs. Broiler pen will count as 1 of the maximums of 2 species an exhibitor is eligible to sell.

POULTRY PROJECT MEMBERS

4-H Poultry project members that wish to participate in the Youth Livestock Auction at the Bourbon County Fair will need to have Broiler Chickens ordered by May 3rd. All birds for this project will come from the same hatch and will be Cornish cross and will be available approx. 6-7 weeks before fair 4hrs. will be notified when birds are ready for pickup. Price per bid TBD hatch time but approx. \$3.15 per bird. Number of bird's minimum order of 10. Contact the Extension Office before May 3, 2024 by calling 620-223-3720.
