For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$4,320 for each additional person per year.

Note:

- *Households with income from 100%-400% of the federal poverty level (FPL) are eligible for Advanced Premium Tax Credits for insurance purchased through the Marketplace. Depending on the price of the plans available, tax credits may actually phase out before 400% FPL.*
- *If Kansas expands its Medicaid (KanCare) program, those with income up to 138% FPL would be eligible for Medicaid (KanCare).*
- *Households with income up to 250% FPL are eligible for cost sharing subsidies if they purchase a Silver plan in the Marketplace.*
