A one day grazing school is tentatively scheduled for Saturday September 28, 2019 in Bourbon County, Kansas. The School will

feature classroom style presentations, on topics such as the economics of grazing, and extending winter grazing with cover crops. Two ranch visits are also tentatively scheduled, featuring a rotational grazing system, and alternative methods of pasture production including bermuda grass, and switching from spring to fall calving on fescue pastures.
