

# 2019 Rental Rates: Bourbon County

Local farmland and rangeland rental rate data is one of the most frequently utilized pieces of information from an extension office. This data set comes directly from a survey of Woodson County, Kansas farmers and ranchers.

This data set is for informational purposes only. It represents a snapshot of what the survey participants have indicated they are paying / charging for agricultural land for 2019. You will need to consider your own unique circumstances when determine equitable rental rates. Items to consider include acreages and condition of the land, fences, watering systems, working facilities etc. Tenant / landowner relations are also important considerations, along with weed control, rental contact beginning and end dates, soil fertility, oral vs. written leases and more. Contact your local extension agent for more details.

## Native Grass Pastures

- **Average Rent Per Acre \$24.00**
- Range from \$10-32.50
- Lease split between 6 month and 12 months

## Crop Land

- **Average Rent Per Acre of \$58.00**
- Range from \$25 -\$100
- High variability. Probably due to soil quality.



## Cool Season (Fescue Pasture)

- **Average Rent Per Acre \$22.50**
- Range of \$20-38

## Stocking Rate

- **Average of 5.5 Acres**

## Hunting Leases

**\$5.00 to \$17.00 acre or \$250-\$1300 person**

**Native Hay Avg of \$32**

**Fescue Hay Avg of \$28**
