Rules and Regulations

Requirements of Animals

1. All swine must have a 4-H ID tag and ear notch. No out-of-county pigs tagged without prior approval.
2. All males must be castrated.
3. Hogs must be owned and shown by exhibitor.
4. All hogs must be born on or after January 1, 2019.
5. No minimum or maximum weights.
6. Swine originating in Kansas must be free of clinical signs of infestations or contagious disease. All Swine originating or purchased out-of-state must follow state guidelines, have a valid health certificate within the prior 30 days, and have a negative blood test or originate from a disease free herd. Health papers required for out-of-state entries only.

Registration

1. All exhibitors must be current 4-H members, 4-H age 7-18 (as of 1/1/19).
2. Pre-entry & entry fee must be postmarked by May 29, 2019.
3. Breed classes must have 3 head registered. If less than 3 register, they will show in the crossbred class.
4. Late entry fee of \$25/head due at check-in.
5. There is no fee for showmanship classes, provided exhibitor participates in at least one prospect class.
6. There will be no refunds.

Show Day

1. Exhibitor may bring bedding material, but must clean pen(s) prior to leaving the fairgrounds.
2. Exhibitors must register with the Spring Swine Show. Declare weights or weigh animals upon arrival during the scheduled check-in/weigh-in period.
3. Custom fitters will not be permitted to do any fitting or feeding of animals at the Spring Swine Show. Violation of this rule may disqualify the exhibitor from participation.
4. No mistreatment of animals is allowed.
5. Classes will be separated by breeds and weights. Gilts and barrows will show together.
6. Animals shown in market classes may not show in breeding classes.
7. All classes of one breed will be shown before moving to the next breed.
8. Judge will place animals shown on their quality compared to the breed standard. All decisions will be final.
9. All persons who attend or participate in the show do so at their own risk. Wabaunsee County 4-H and Fair Board assume no risk.
10. The Spring Swine Show directors reserve the right to decide any questions not covered in the list of rules.
